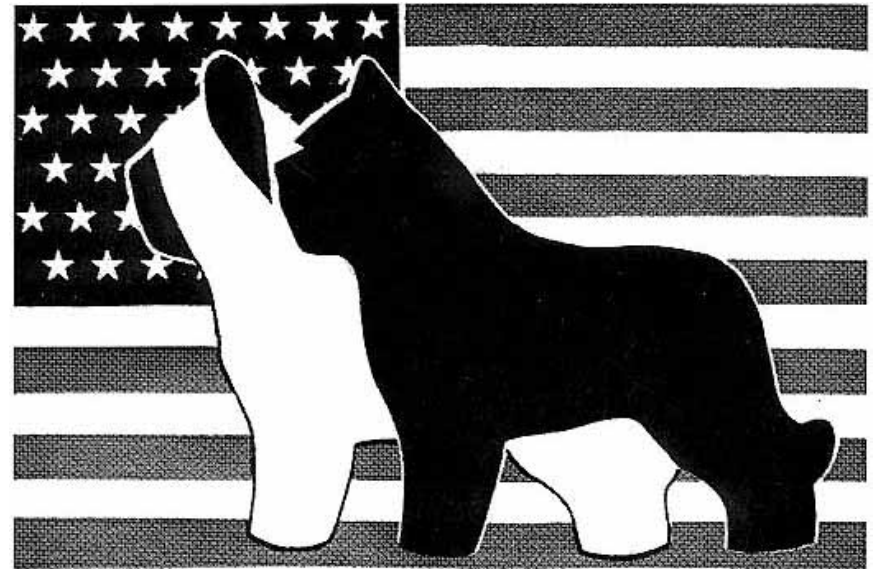

"Danny Quest Design" Challenge Trophy - The Briard Club of America offers a challenge trophy for High Scoring Briard in Trial. The award will go to the Briard who earns the highest qualifying score over all the days of the trial on either Course A or Course C. The trophy will be a Dannyquest design of a Briard herding motif to be awarded on a permanent basis to the owner who wins it three times, not necessarily with the same dog. The challenge trophy will have the name of the winner engraved on the base. The trophy will remain in the possession of the Briard Club of America until permanently awarded. A Dannyquest design Briard statue will be awarded to be retained by the winner.

Overall High Scoring Briard – Rosette & Trophy – for Briard with the highest total over the two day trial regardless of course or class; the highest score per day will be used if the dog earns multiple qualifying scores.

High Scoring Veteran Briard in Trial – Rosette & Trophy - (Dog must be 7 years or older the day of the trial) – highest scoring Briard over the two days.

High Scoring Briard who is also an AKC Champion of Record – Rosette & Trophy – highest scoring Briard over the two days.

High Scoring Briard with an AKC Performance Title – Rosette & Trophy – highest scoring Briard over the two days.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Herding Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with an international money order guaranteed in U.S. funds. **A separate entry form must be submitted for each entry.** Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies with out the agreement and rules are unacceptable. Telephone, telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing date.
The club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

TRIAL REGULATIONS

Proof of current rabies vaccinations must be furnished upon request.

All dogs must be held on leash, except during trial. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the trial area. Handlers should bring water and shade and pick up after their dogs. This Show will be open from 6 AM to 9 PM. CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM for time of judging.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused.

ENTRY FEE shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

LUNCH will be available at the show – sign up required that morning.
