RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee of \$30.00 will be added to each returned check.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whoever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly and carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: Briard Club of America (BCA) may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against BCA or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial. A refund will be given, less a \$5.00 fee, if the Secretary is notified prior to the trial start and an alternate takes that run. No alternate, no refund.

BITCHES IN SEASON will run in catalog order in all trial classes, but will be placed at the end of the running order in all test classes.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations.

YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.

EXPRESS MAIL ENTRIES – If you send your entries via some type of overnight service, you **MUST** waive recipient signature with some carriers, otherwise the delivery person will not leave the envelope which can cause a delay in the secretary receiving your entries.

Directions

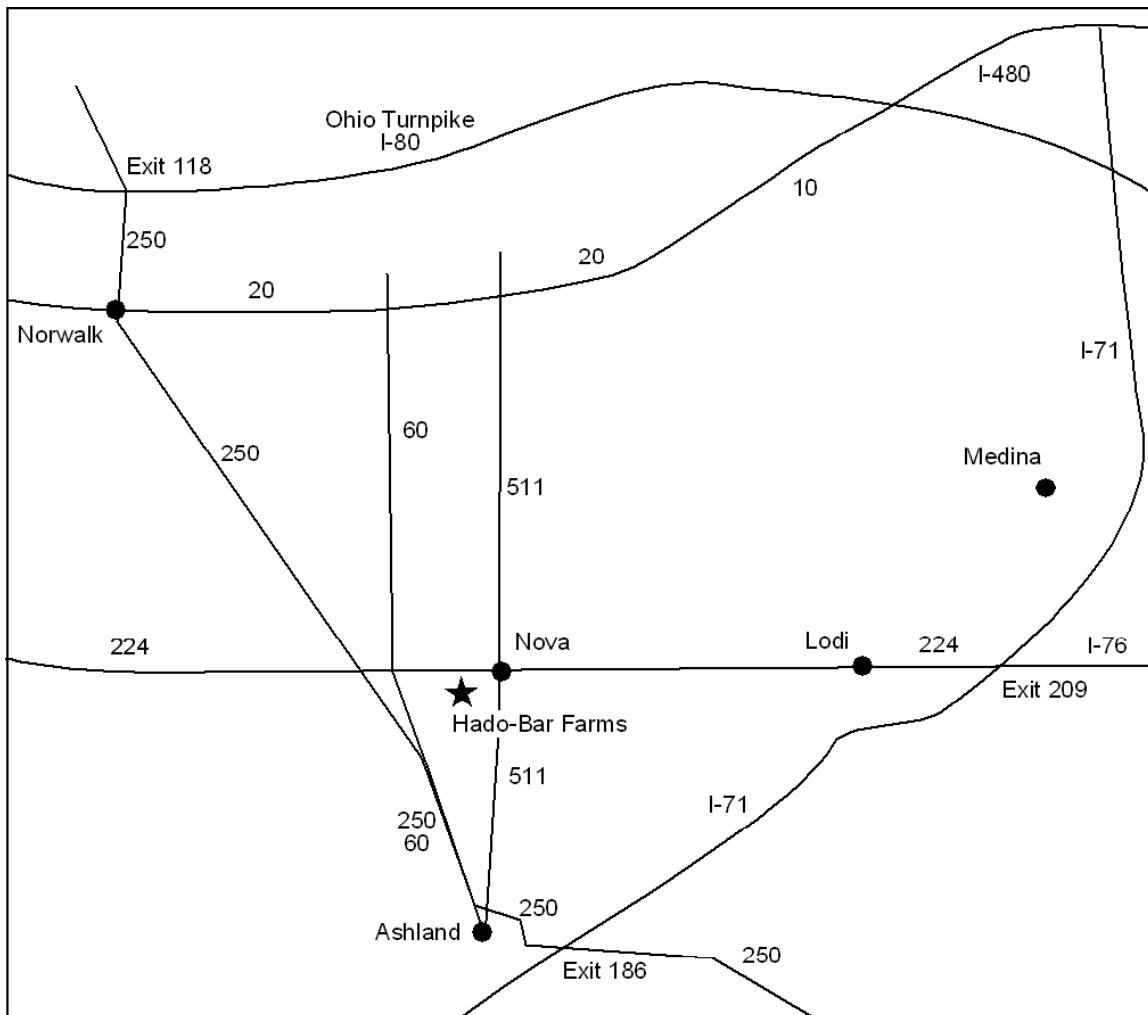
Nova, Ohio is about 20 minutes north of Ashland and an hour southwest of Cleveland, at the intersections of Rts. 224 E-W and 511 N-S. From Rt. I-71, go West.

From Michigan, take I-75 to the Ohio Turnpike East towards Cleveland. Exit at Gate 7, which is Route 250 South. Take Rt. 250 South to Rt. 224, then East on 224.

From the North on Rt. 20, take Rts. 301, 58 or 511 South to Rt. 224 and turn West.

From Ashland, where the motels are, take Rt. 250 North to Rt. 224 and turn East.

County Rd. 1171 is about 2 miles West of Rt. 511 and a little less East of Rt. 250. Turn South and it's the first farm on the right. There is a sign on the corner in the shape of a sheep that says Hado Bar Farm.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and the "Regulations for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or the lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequences of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

I (we) agree that a cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event between AKC and/or the event-giving club and myself (ourselves) or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association.
