NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. No refunds given under \$10.00 for your wrong addition.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Preferred classes may not run in a higher height division.
- **Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. **Please note:** Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in the trial that come in season after the closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary before the start of the show. Entry fees will be refunded minus \$6.00 which also includes AKC fee per day/trial.
- Injured dogs are not permitted to compete in agility trials. Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean for future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- AVMA Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

"Refunds - There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the Closing Date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal; except that refunds (less judging fees incurred) will be given for a dog which suffers an injury or illness or bitches which come into heat after the Closing Date."

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs, purebred and mixed breed, over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breeds are allowed as long as they have been registered with the AKC. Refer to Chapter 3, Section 22 of the Dog Show Rules.

Jump Height Cards - New Policy

Jump Height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked and that the dog is measured prior to running.

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height division. Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter at the Novice level in both Pref. Std and Pref JWW and Pref. FAST. Exhibitors with dogs that have an expired temporary card as of the date of the trial, or that have a dog that has not been measured, must check the box on the entry form "My dog needs to be measured." These dogs will have their armbands withheld until the dog is measured by the judge of record for the weekend, or by an AKC rep or VMO if present. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that their dogs have been measured prior to running. When getting your dog measured, please fill out the form BEFORE you ask to be measured.

If northbound or southbound on I-75, go east on I-275 to SR42 (Exit 46, Sharonville exit). Turn north (left) onto Rt.42. Turn left at first traffic light (Hauck Road) once you've crossed over I-275. Go west on Hauck Road for about 3/4 mile, turn right (north) onto Tramway. Follow Tramway to end - Queen City building is at end of street, on your right.

If northbound or southbound on I-71, go west on I-275 to Rt.42 (Exit 46, Sharonville exit). Turn north (right) onto Rt.42. Move to left lane. Turn left at first traffic light (Hauck Road). Go west on Hauck Road for about 3/4 mile, turn right (north) onto Tramway. Follow Tramway to end - Queen City building is at end of street, on your right.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
