BREED HISTORY

1 Could you give us a brief history of the Briard? For what was the breed developed and how has it progressed over the years?

2 How would you describe Briard temperament?

3 In your opinion, how would you describe the ideal home for a Briard? How are they with children?

4 Which breeders of the past/present do you admire?

5 Did you read books to learn more about Briards? If so, please name a few of your favorite ones.

6 Other than a dog you were associated with, would you name three of the best Briards you've ever seen and what their greatest assets are/were?

7 Are Briards a breed of preservation or a breed of evolving, (developmental) phenotype? (For example, the earlier big winners in breeds such as Poodles, Dobermans, Cocker Spaniels etc. compared to the ones we now commonly see.)

1 How many years have you been breeding Briards? How many litters have you had? Are you still breeding? When was your last litter?

16 Are your dogs generally owner handled, or do you utilize professional handlers?

18 Looking back on your many years in the Sport, what experiences would you point to as reasons why new breeders should get into our Sport?

19 Do you take performance/companion considerations into your breeding decisions? Other than conformation, in what other events do you (and/or those with your bloodline) typically engage with your dogs?

BREEDING & TRAINING THEORY: PART I

2 How long after you acquired your first Briard did you have your first litter?

3 How did the puppies turn out in your first litter? Did that litter serve as the actual foundation for *<insert kennel name>*? Or was it more of a "lessons learned" litter?

10 We talk about some people having an "eye" for a dog." How can you suggest that a less-experienced breeder cultivate such "an eye"?

11 At what age do you like to pick your puppies? What qualities would you look for in a puppy of that age? Have they ever turned out differently from what you had envisioned them to be?

12 Have you co-owned with others before? How has that worked out for you? Would you recommend co-ownership to others getting started? (Or others slowing down on breeding?)

13 If you could give new breeders one or two words of advice, what would they be?

14At what age/ages do you evaluate a litter?

15 What specific things do you look for in making puppy selections from your litters?

16 Describe your puppy socialization program and at what age you begin.

BREEDING & TRAINING THEORY: PART II

1 Do you use a particular breeding method? How do you feel about inbreeding, outcrossing and linebreeding? What do you feel the risks are of each?

2 Can you speak to your value of phenotype and/versus genotype? (How do you calculate a comfortable balance?)

3 Are any/most of your litters bred using frozen/chilled semen? What do you feel is the advantage/disadvantage of using AI for breeding over a natural breeding?

4 At what age do you start show training your puppies?

5 How do you get your Briards show ready?

6 What do you think of the adage- "If you like the son breed to the father"? Or a full litter brother?

7 What are your thoughts regarding an "open kennel" and a "closed kennel" in regard to breeding and the future of the breed?

8 How do you feel about multi-sired litters? Have you used this provision?

9 Have you incorporated foreign blood lines into you breeding program? Were you pleased with the results?

BREEDING & TRAINING THEORY: PART III

1 What has been your greatest challenge while breeding/showing?

2 What do you think is the main conformation problem in the breed today? Anything non conformation/standard related?

3 How would you describe the ideology behind your breeding?

4 Have you ever used frozen semen? How old was it when you used it? (Was the stud dog still alive at the time? How long since he had passed - or contributed to the gene pool?) Did you learn about AI from trial and error? Did you have a specific reproduction mentor/s?

6 Do you have any suggestions for working with co-owners/co-breeders?
